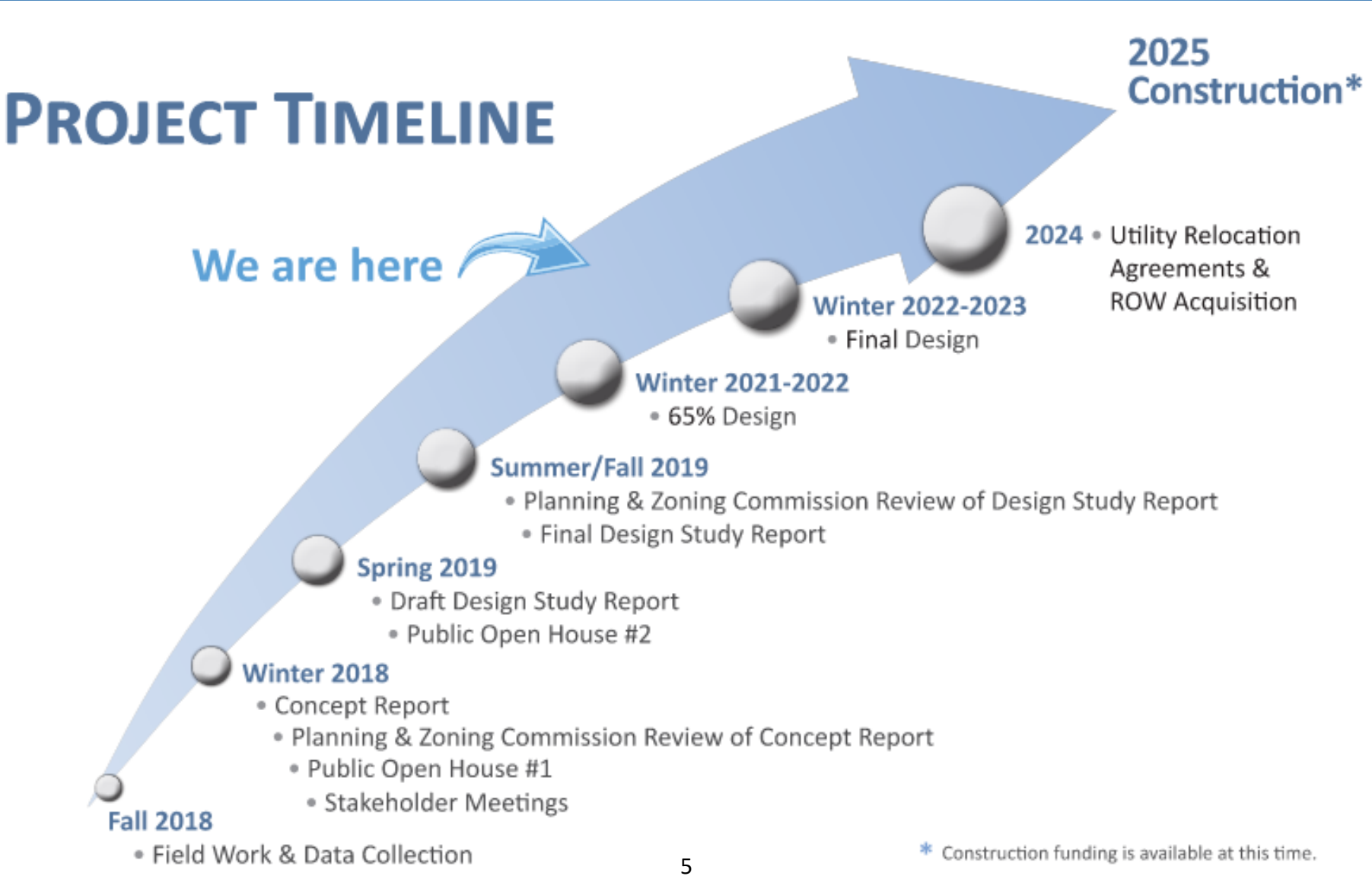

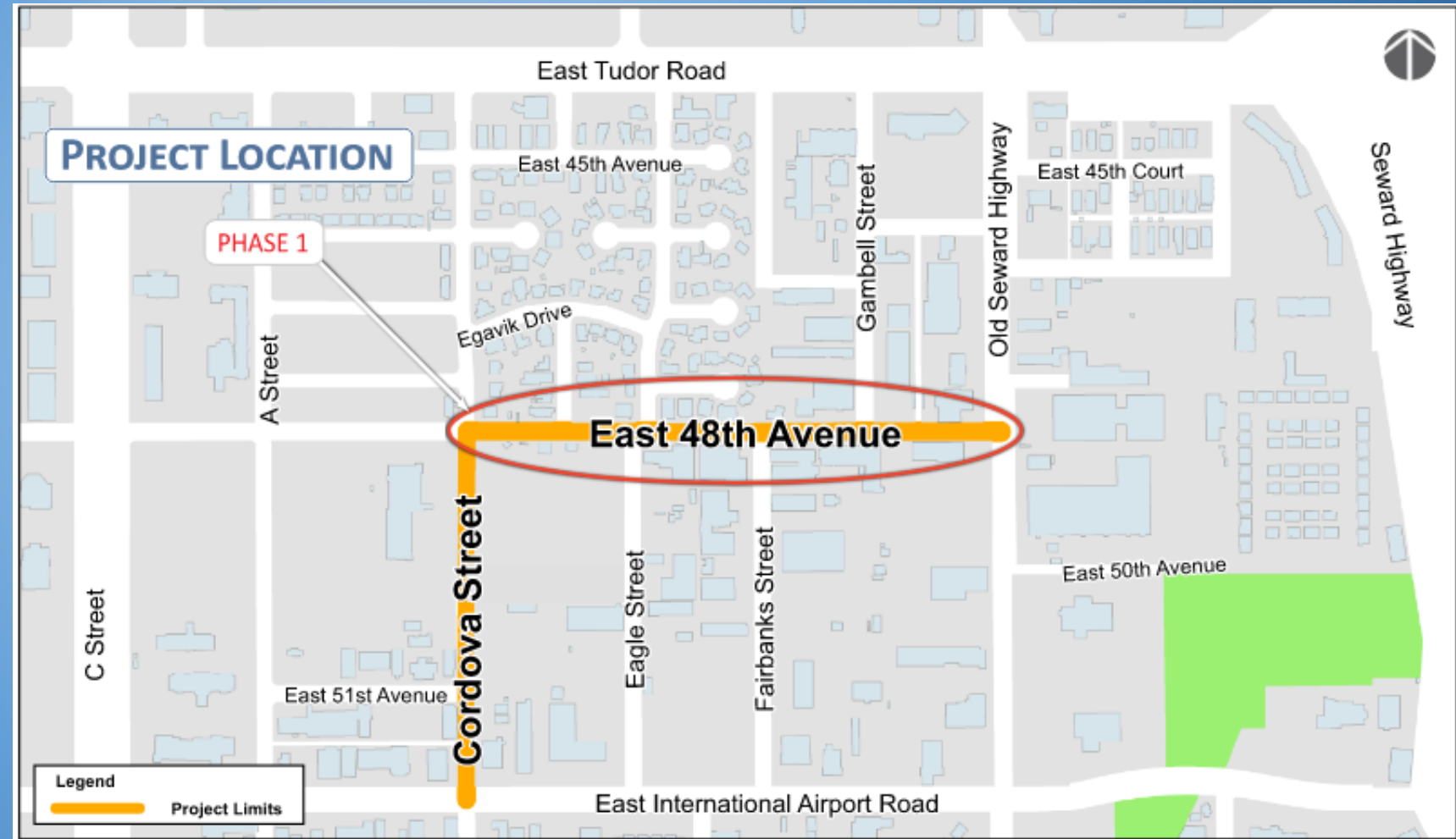

PROJECT AREA MAP

The 48th Avenue & Cordova Street Reconstruction project has been split into multiple phases to conform to available funding.

The first phase will consist of improvements to 48th Avenue from Cordova Street to Old Seward Highway (48th Avenue Upgrade project)

This segment was selected due to the discovery of failing storm drain pipe below the roadway that must be corrected as soon as possible.

PROJECT PURPOSE AND NEED

- The purpose of the project is to reconstruct E. 48th Avenue, which will require upgrading it to current MOA Collector Roadway standards.
- The project is needed because existing roadways and drainage systems are failing and it is no longer feasible to economically maintain them.
- The project is also needed to support proposed development along the roadway corridor which will increase vehicle and non-motorized traffic.

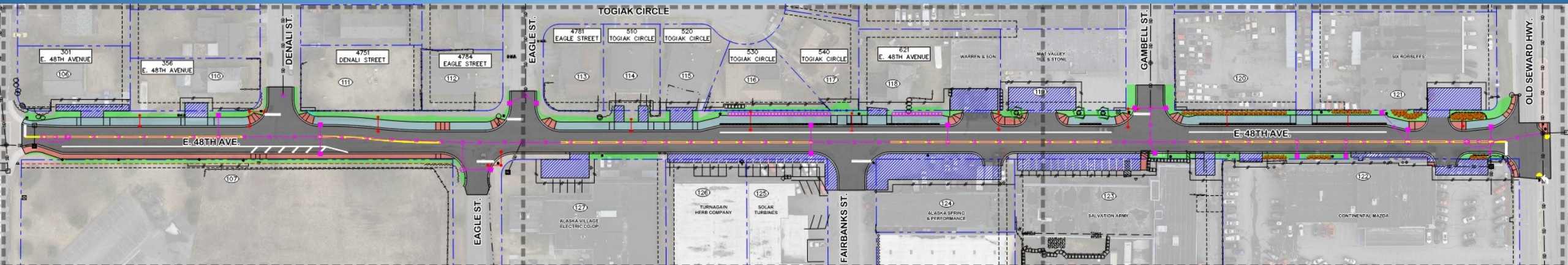

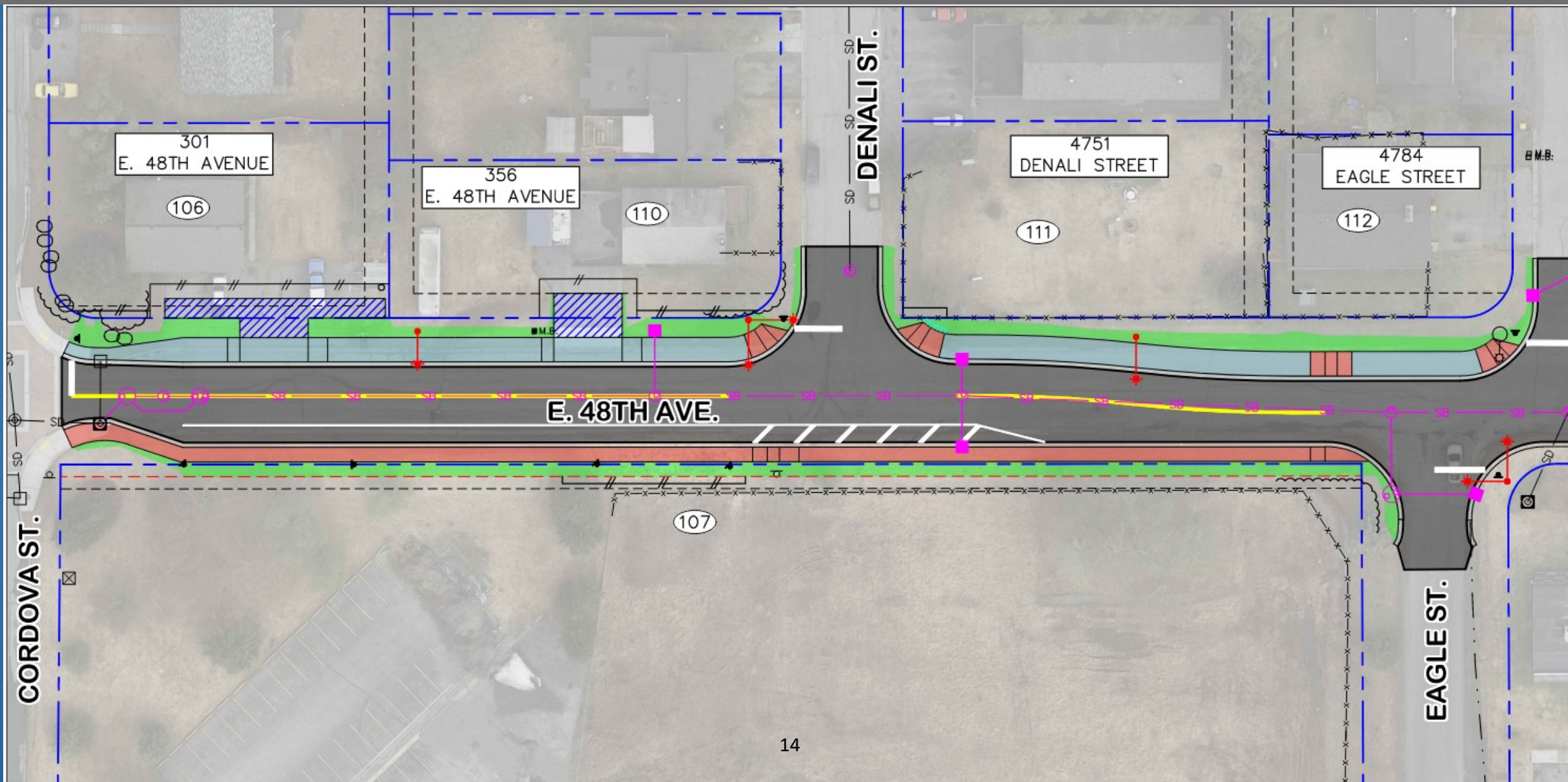
Roadway Corridor - 65% Design

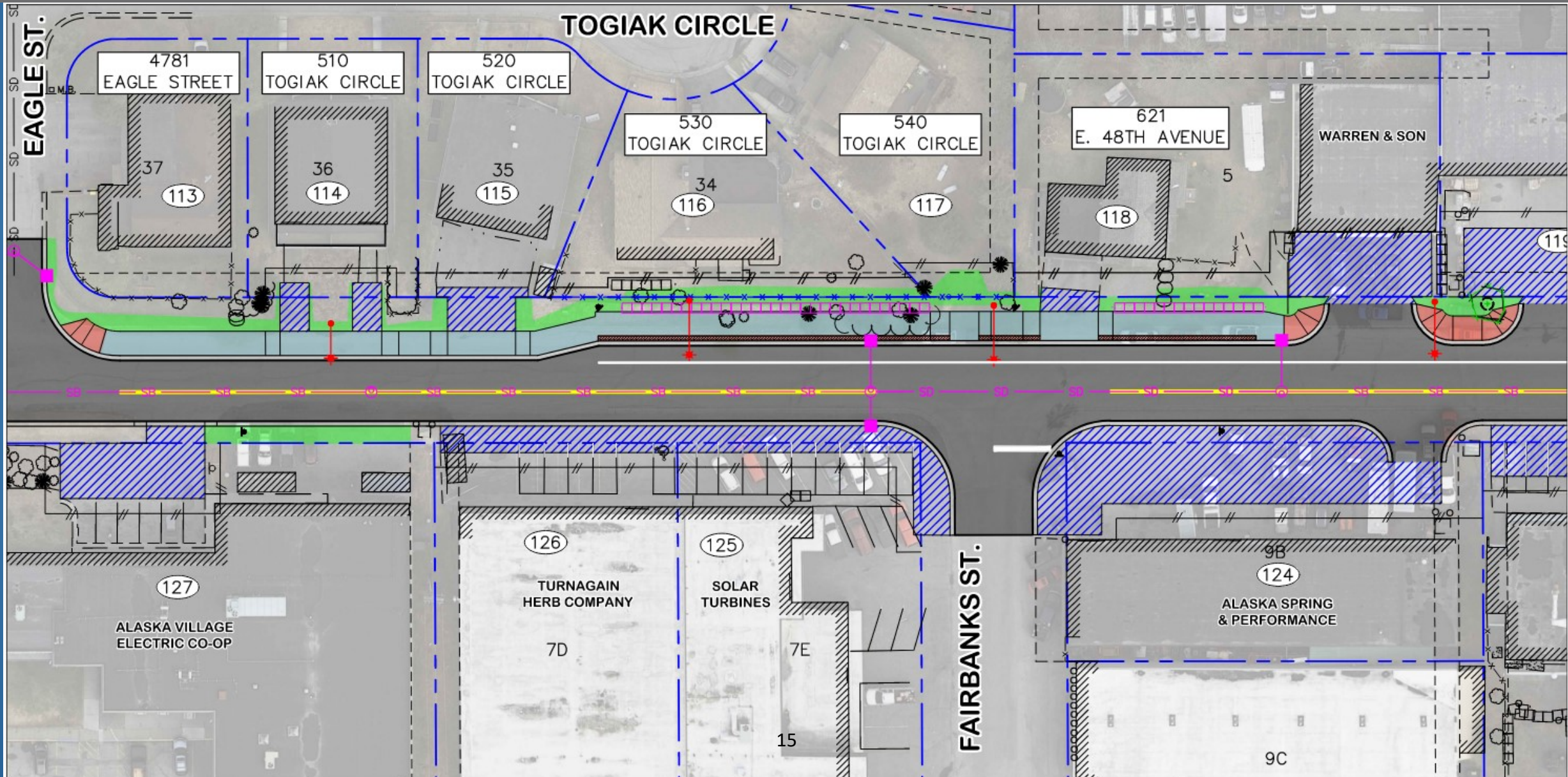

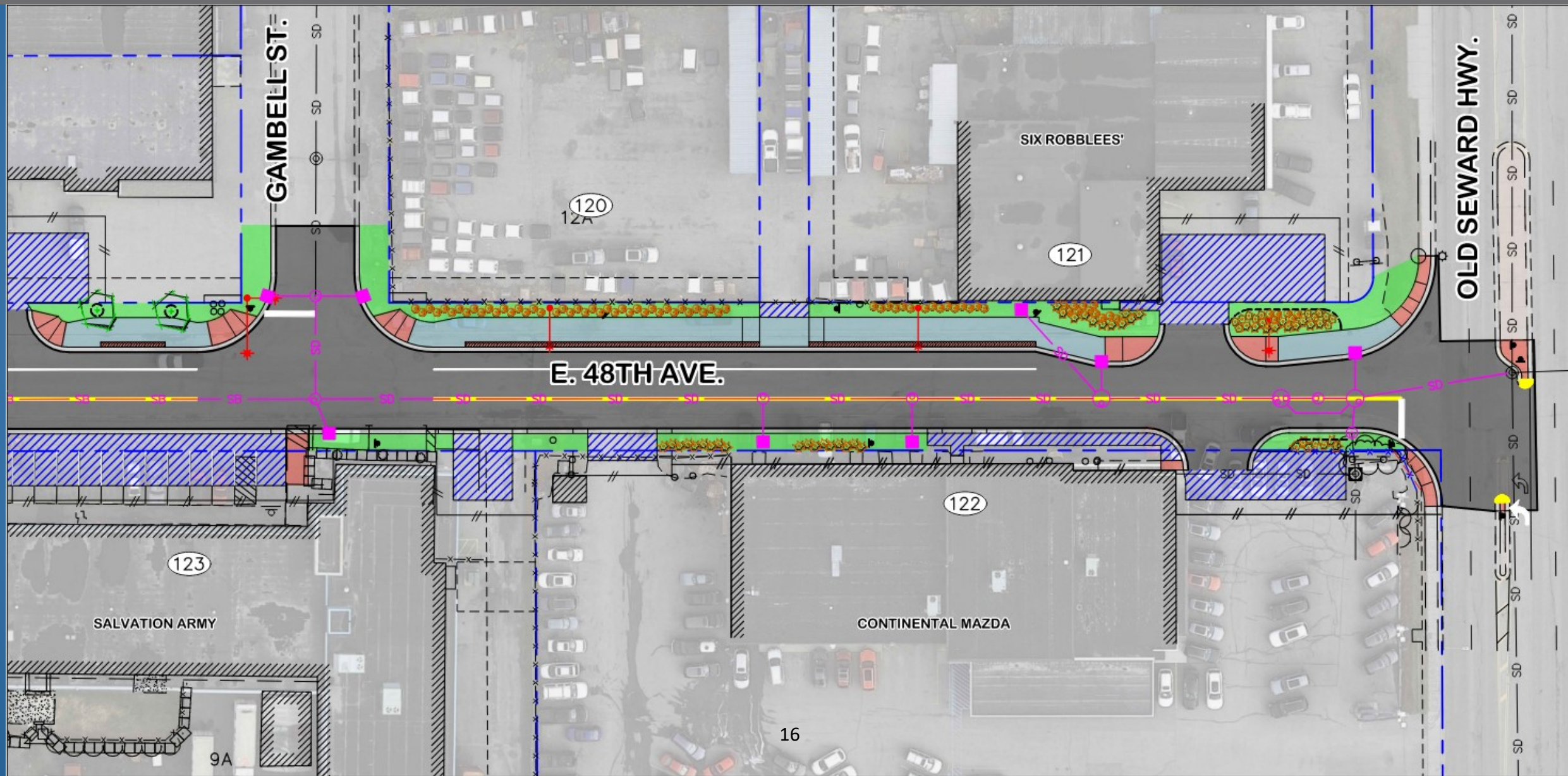

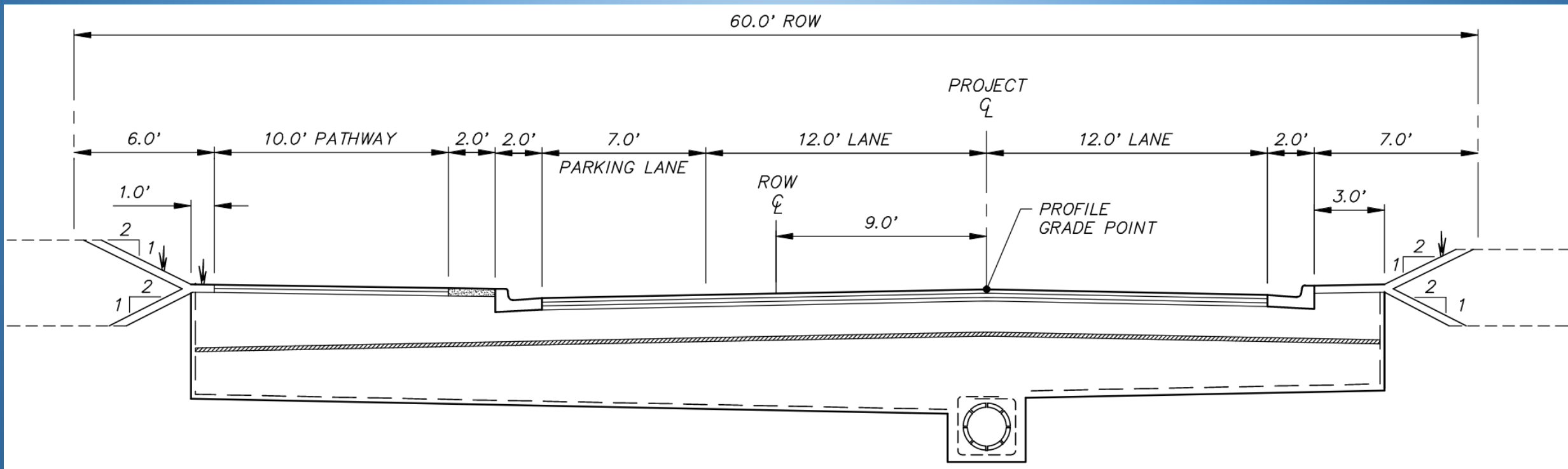

Next Steps

- Gather stakeholder and public comments on the 65% Design
 - Submit comments by end of April 2022
 - Full set of plans and specifications are available on website
- Present 65% Design to Urban Design Commission (June 2022)
- Modify and update plans to 95% Complete
- Host another public open house at 95% complete design (2023)
- Begin working with utility companies to plan relocation of their facilities (2024)
- Prepare construction documents
- Advertise project for bid
- Construct proposed improvements (2025)
